


#### **Alumni Wall of Distinction Nominations Sought**

# Louis E. Dieruff High School Alumni Wall of Distinction NOMINATION FORM

**Purpose:** To give lasting recognition to graduates of Dieruff High School who have made exceptional contributions in their field, bringing honor to themselves and to Dieruff High School. Furthermore, it is the purpose of the Alumni Wall of Distinction to promote Husky Pride among current students, inspiring them to strive toward future accomplishments.

**Criteria For Nomination:** Nominees eligible for selection must have conducted themselves in such manner to reflect honor upon Dieruff High School, and have qualities of character and standards of conduct that are exemplary. Alumnni must have graduated at least ten years prior to their nomination. Non-Dieruff graduates may be considered for "honorary" status on the Alumni Wall of Distinction.

Nominees must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Demonstrated commitment to and involvement with Dieruff High School and the community at an exceptional level.
- 2. Outststanding, enduring contribution to society by making a difference in the lives of others.
- 3. Outstanding professional contribution or achievement in his/her chosen field or endeavor. Considered categories are listed: (A) Arts (B) Business (C) Education (D) Entertainment / TV / Film (E) Financial (F) Economic Development (G) Government (H) Historian (I) Law / Criminal Justice (J) Media / Journalism / Writing (K) Medicine / Health Science (L) Military

#### Attention: All Alumni Military Veterans

Once again, The Dieruff High School Alumni Association is seeking military veterans who attended Dieruff High School during the Vietnam War, but did not graduate due to entry into the military service. "*Operation Recognition*", established by the Pennsylvania State Legislature, authorizes school districts to grant a high school diploma to any eligible veteran who served during World War II, the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam War.

We are pleased to announce that Louis E. Dieruff High School is proud to participate in this program and we are anxious to locate, recognize, and honor those veterans who meet the following requirements:

- 1. Was honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States.
- 2. Served in the U.S. military between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975.
- 3. Attended Dieruff High School between 1959 and 1975 during the Vietnam War.
- 4. Would have been a member of a graduating Class from 1960 through 1975 and did not graduate due to entry into military service.
- 5. Deceased alumni can receive diplomas posthumously and awarded to family members on their behalf.

Also, please note that upon proper application, a diploma shall be awarded posthumously to a veteran who meets the stated requirements.

The inaugural recipients were presented posthumously at the Graduation Ceremony for the Class of 2016 to Dennis Wayne Burian, USMC (Class of 1968) and Richard Michael Seng, USMC (Class of 1967). Both were killed in action during the Vietnam War in 1968. Sharon Burian Antrim '66 accepted the diploma on behalf of her brother and Mrs. Mary Seng, 96-year-old mother accepted the diploma on behalf of her son. The diplomas were presented by a USMC serviceman and bouquets of flowers were presented by two AFJROTC cadets.

Please let's keep up this tradition. Brigadoon was Dieruff's first attempt at a major musical production in 1968




#### **Husky Happenings - Freshmen Football Signing Ceremony**




