



And this year, things will get even better. We have outgrown the East Side Youth Center, and so we have booked the **South Mountain Grove** in Allentown. A huge open-air banquet pavilion can accommodate 700 people under one roof, and the picnic tables can be arranged to permit separation of the reunion classes. Separate bar and food serving stations inside the pavilion ensure quick and easy service. Spacious parking lots ensure convenient access.

The Grove will be serving a lavish menu of food, which includes meatballs, ziti, turkey BBQ, sausage and peppers with rolls, potato salad, Cole slaw, baked beans, veggie tray, fruit tray, relish tray with pickles and olives, and chip/pretzels. Here is a message from Louis E. Dieruff High School teacher and Yearbook advisor, Mr. Luke Boyd.



Nominees must meet one or more of the following criteria:


- Demonstrated commitment to and involvement with Dieruff High School and the community at an exceptional level.
