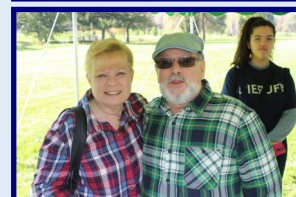

And so, I encourage you to join in the fun. Missing the 2018 Tailgate Party would be... ah, "senseless".

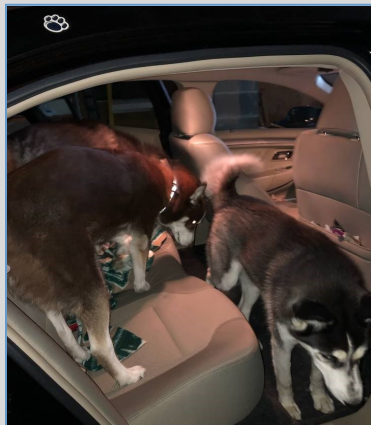

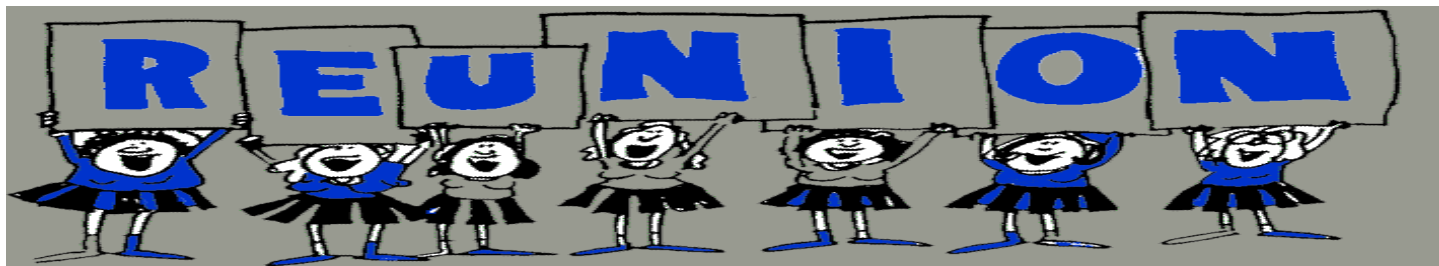

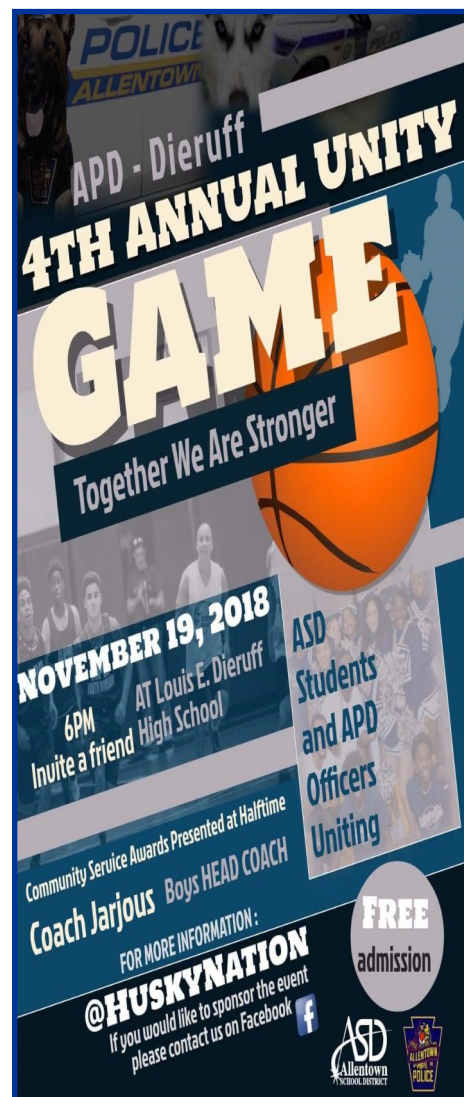
